# New Owner Makes Improvements At Jomax

Golf Carts Sales And Service Is A Team Effort

Jomax Golf Carts has been a staple in Zephyrhills for dozens of years, offering different services throughout its stay. However, over time it has become clear what the small, but specialized, staff excels in: golf carts.

After taking over the wheel at Jomax on April 1, Marty Rood has vowed to bring the shop into the "modern golf cart world."

He started working at Jomax three years ago, when it was run by local duo Bob and Cheryl Maxon. When the Maxons retired, Rood jumped at the opportunity to purchase the store located at 37746 Eiland Blvd.

"I fell in love with the business. I fell in love with the customers," Rood said. "There's not a lot of people that can actually say they love what they do. We can say that."

"I can say that," confirmed Jomax employee Michael Gray.

Although Rood's name is on the checkbook, it's a team effort at Jomax. Rood relies on the experience of long-time employees Gray and Peter Karpys to help make all major decisions in the shop.

Eric Farrar has been added to the team since the change in management, bringing his powder coating and laser etching business in to enhance custom golf carts.

The most evident change at Jomax is the physical appearance of the shop. The inside of the store has been redesigned to be more customer friendly and efficient. A new sign is also being installed in front of the store to clearly identify it as solely a golf cart shop.


When most athletes want to be successful, one of their top priorities when they make it big is to take care of their mom.

For 15-year-old amateur boxer Roberto Gomez of Zephyrhills, his love for the sport and his talent have propelled him to be one of the top young amateur fighters in the country.

"At this point, boxing is a lifestyle, but when I'm in school, it's all about getting good grades," said Gomez, who just graduated from Stewart Middle School a few weeks ago. "When I'm in the ring, it's about boxing. Wherever you are, it's about being focused."

Gomez plans to prove he's one of the best again next week in the USA Boxing

Joamx was previously used as a car dealership and for other trades, which was confusing for customers, Rood said. However, the shop does still test and install batteries for all automotive needs.

The Jomax name, from the original owners, has been retained. The people of Zephyrhills know the Jomax name, and Rood said he was not willing to take that away from the town.

Golf carts at Jomax range in price from \$2,500 to as much as \$12,000. Interested customers can buy a cart right off the showroom floor, or can make customizations that can take up to two weeks to fulfill, depending on available parts.

The custom carts, and the customers that come with them, are one of the best parts of the job for the guys at Jomax.

"It's amazing, for starters... Everybody knows who it is by the cart coming up the street," Rood said. "They're proud of it. They're creative. Our customers are teaching us creativity."

Rood intends to participate in every upcoming parade, and has invited customers to enter their custom carts alongside them.

While Jomax does its best to compete with Internet prices, they encourage interested buyers to at least call or stop by the store to see what their team can do. Jomax offers full maintenance and repairs for golf carts and will work on any golf cart a customer brings in for service or repair, regardless of what brand it is or where they bought it.

"Let us work on it. Let us help you with the parts," Rood said.

The shop's hours have also been changed to better meet the needs of locals and working-class customers. Jomax is now open from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday and from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturdays.

Junior Olympics Championships in Charleston, W.Va., where he will battle for a spot in the 140-145-pound weight class in his age group.

He won the Junior Olympic national crown in Dallas, Texas last year in the intermediate class, but has moved up to the class where he could earn himself an opportunity to represent the United States in international competition.

Working with trainer Salvador Jaurequi in Dade City, Gomez won a state title and took the regional crown this year to qualify him for the Junior Olympics national tournament.

His time in the ring stems from his upbringing and situations from his past in Lacoochee. Ultimately, his goal is to help his mother, Quiana Hambrick, and his sisters.

A soon-to-be Zephyrhills High School freshman, he has his sights set on being the best and said he wants to be the next Floyd Mayweather. It may be a lofty goal, but one his coach encourages.

"You have to have big dreams," Jaurequi said. "Take it one day at a time. You take the baby steps to get where you're going,"

In his preparation for the Junior Olympics, Gomez has been sparring with some of the best junior fighters in the state.

"Right now, it's strictly boxing," Gomez said. "I'm doing three workouts a day. I'll be ready."

# Music Once Again Fills Hospice Center's Halls

## Donated Piano Will Provide Music For Years To Come

A special dedication ceremony was held at the Gulfside Center for Hospice Care last Friday to welcome a new, but familiar addition: a piano.

The halls of the center at 5760 Dean Dairy Road had been missing the sweet tunes of piano music for two months. A long time Gulfside volunteer who had previously donated the use of his piano to the center moved out of the Zephyrhills area and took his piano with him.

Volunteer and pianist John Poore, PhD, stepped in to fill the void and to bring the gift of music back to patients, families and staff.

Poore found Greg Sikosek, who was originally looking to sell his piano before moving from his Palm Harbor residence.

"When it came down to the piano and the opportunity to donate it came up it seemed like the right thing to do," Sikosek said. "It's a nice setting here. I'm very happy it's going to be played – I'm sure a great deal more than I've been able to in recent years."

The black, upright Kawai piano sits comfortably in one of the back corners of the center's family area overlooking a pond. Before the dedication ceremony started, Poore took his turn tickling the ivories as volunteers and patients smiled, occasionally closing their eyes to relax and listen.

Rabbi Aaron Lever, patient care

volunteer and counseling services program manager at Gulfside Hospice, led the ceremony, thanking Poore and Sikosek for their contributions to the center. A plaque was placed atop the piano declaring how it came to sit in the room, so the donation will always be remembered.

Lever even tried out the keys, playing

"Leaves on the Seine" by David Lanz, to conclude the ceremony. The center's chef, Ruth Estice, put out a spread of fruit, vegetables and other light fare and sweets for the 2 p.m. dedication.

"The staff and the volunteers that worked in the building were very sad when the piano left... That was a fixture in this building," Lever said about the time without a piano. "For years to come hundreds and hundreds of patients and families are going to be touched because of this piano and everything that Greg and John did."

Poore also donated the resources to have the piano tuned upon its arrival to make sure every note was pitch perfect.




